WHO ARE WE?

We are the Touring-Caravan Section of "The Camping and Caravanning Club"

The British Caravanners Club (BCC) is a special interest section of The Camping and Caravanning Club.

We are big enough to be a national section and also small enough to be friendly. Each area is run by a committee of its own members, and we always welcome your feedback good or not so good!

Although we may historically be the Touring-Caravan Section, we welcome all types of unit from tent to motorhome, as long as you are a member of The Camping and Caravanning Club, you are always more than welcome to visit any of our sections weekend rallies or Temporary Holiday Sites.



To join our section costs a mere £ on top of the annual Club fee. When you join, you receive a programme which lists every BCC section meet of the year and you will also receive copies of our own 'Caravanning' magazine, written by members for members, with photos sent in by campers, news of special upcoming events, and news from the various areas in the BCC.

Every year a special 5 day meet is organised over the August Bank Holiday. During this weekend all the areas come together for the BCC Feast Of Lanterns where lights and displays are put up by members, for everyone's enjoyment.

Areas hold weekend and 5 day meets between March and November. There are also Temporary Holiday Sites (THS's) in all parts of the country which are run by members, including some which are run by the Councillors of the BCC for the enjoyment of all members. This gives members a chance to meet and get to know their Councillors. Several areas hold 'special' meets and events, birthday meets, Christmas & New Year, fun weekends etc.

The BCC has its own Technical Officer who writes articles in each edition of 'Caravanning' and runs a 'Technical Forum' at the F.O.L. We also have our own Supplies Officer who procures an extensive range and continually varying collection of Regalia that is available to all areas, and via the 'Caravanning' magazine.



There are no extra charges for awnings, pup-tents, children or dogs, just a simple fee per unit per night. Some areas charge a fixed cost price throughout the season for their weekend meets, so you know just how much you're going to pay for your weekend.

Children are welcome and encouraged to camp with the BCC, and some areas have dedicated Youth Officers.
